
## Inclusion at the start menu (running schedule at the computer start )

This option generates a link with the start menu so that when computer starts, if there are annotations for today or tomorrow (and only in this case) the schedule is shown with the annotations.

For active it you must select it in the menu Configuration:



And accept, or modify if necessary, the implied directories:
